Air Canada Contest

Coupe Charles-Bruneau in Québec, 2026 Edition

Rules and Conditions:

The Event:

The Coupe Charles-Bruneau in Quebec is a friendly ball hockey tournament benefiting the Charles-Bruneau Foundation. The event will take place on May 23 at Place Jean-Béliveau.

Prize to be won:

A pair of round-trip Economy Class tickets for travel within North America, including Hawaii, Mexico, and the Caribbean. These tickets are valid for scheduled flights operated by Air Canada, Air Canada Express, and Air Canada Rouge only.

Important Dates:

The contest runs from April 8 to May 22, 2026, at 12:00 p.m.

The draw will take place on Saturday, May 23, 2026, during the ceremony announcing the total amount raised.

Eligibility:

- The contest is reserved for teams that have tripled or quadrupled the minimum fundraising amount, \$15,000 or more (based on a \$5,000 baseline).
- Individual fundraising is not eligible.
- Entries are allocated based on the number of team members (players and supporters) at the time of the final draft.

Allocation of Entries:

- A team that has tripled its fundraising (\$15,000 to \$19,999) receives 1 entry per member.
- A team that has quadrupled its fundraising (\$20,000 and more) receives 2 entries per member.
- Entries are then pooled into an individual draw among all eligible members.

Draw :

One winner will be randomly selected from all entries.
